Terms & conditions:

- No limit to the number of toys each swapper can bring for the event.
- Only kids and/or family-friendly toys will be accepted.
- Only toys in these categories will be accepted: building sets and blocks, dolls and action figurines, educational toys, electronic toys, board/card games in original box with instructions, physical activity (e.g. hula hoop, bowling set), pretend play (e.g. kitchen sets, gardening set), puzzle/assembly, sound toys, spinning toys, vehicles, remote-controlled toys.
- Dough, plasticine, sands, slime sets, plush toys and jigsaw puzzles will not be accepted.
- All toys must be clean, complete and in good working condition. Broken, chipped, or heavily worn toys will not be accepted.
- Each swapper will be given a card. One stamp signifies one toy accepted for the swap.
- All swaps will be on a one-to-one basis, except for the new toys from the organiser.
- One swap card admits an adult and/or a child into the swap area. Last entry is at 5.45pm on 22 & 23 Mar.
- All toys will be checked by the event staff at the drop-off station before being accepted for the swap. Toys smaller than A5-sized will be grouped together (e.g. figurines).
- Swappers can swap 10 of their toys for one new toy from the organiser. Limited to one new toy per swap card.
- 10 new toys will be added into the area hourly (1pm, 2pm, 3pm, 4pm, 5pm).
- Swappers can only check out a maximum of 10 items at any one time. Swappers will have to rejoin the queue to swap for more items.
- Swappers have to ensure that they are satisfied with the condition of the item(s) before checking out. No correspondence will be entertained thereafter.
- Toys left un-swapped will be donated to a charitable organisation.
- By participating in the event, swappers agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the event.
- The organiser reserves the right to reject any toy deemed not suitable for the swap and change any of the terms and conditions without prior notice.
- The organiser cannot ensure that each swapper will be able to swap items of their liking. Swap cards can only be used at the event.
- The organiser's decision on all matters relating to the event is final, conclusive and binding on all swappers.
- The organiser is not liable for any allergic reactions, injuries, or damages caused by the swapped toys.
- The organiser reserves the right to take and use any photograph, video recording, or any other record of this event and its participants for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising.
